General Program Details

Semesters:

- Autumn: mid Sept to mid Jan
- Spring: end of Feb to early June
- Summer: July and August

We provide volunteers with:

- Specific Training for each volunteer program
- Resources and supplies for each program
- Cost of travel to program site

Volunteers are responsible for:

- Time
- Health and Safety



Volunteers must have a minimum age of 18 years old

(16 - 17 years old can be considered for some programs with parental consent after submitting a statement of interest and attending an interview).

Volunteering Program Overview

English Teaching Programs

1. Shanghai English Teaching (SET)

- Overview: Oral English classes for children at schools and community centres in Shanghai and surrounding areas. Some classes also for youth in vocational training. Volunteer teams teach to 10 - 30 students per class at community centres or to 40 - 50 students per class at schools.
- Time commitment: Half a day per week for a minimum of 8 weeks during a school semester or a minimum of 4 half-days during the summer.

2. Home Classroom English Teaching

- Overview: This program started in February 2020, when the Covid-19 virus outbreak prevented students from attending their regular schools. Volunteers teach English online to children in groups of up to six in their homes. Volunteer coordinators who are native Chinese speakers are also needed to liaise with students, parents & volunteer teachers and act as a classroom assistant.
- Time commitment: 2 hours per week (including lesson preparation time) and a minimum of 8 weeks. Teaching schedule is fexible based on volunteers' and students' availability. A minimum of 2 half-days a week for volunteer coordinators.

3. Videolink English Teaching

- Overview: Online classes for children in schools and community centres in rural areas including Henan, Hunan, Anhui, and Yunnan. Volunteers teach English online to 10-15 children located in a classroom.
- Time commitment: 2-3 hours per week (including lesson preparation time) and a minimum of one school term (3-4 months). Teaching schedule is fexible based on volunteers' and students' availability.

4. English Corners

- Overview: Volunteers lead online conversation classes with middle/high school students or local English teachers to create more opportunities for them to learn, practice and improve their English.
- Time commitment: Half a day per week or every other week (including preparation time) and a minimum of one school term (3-4 months).

5. Rural Individual Volunteering

- Overview: Volunteers travel to schools and community centres in rural areas to teach English to rural and left-behind children. Volunteers arrange and pay for visa, insurance, meals, international transport, etc. Stepping Stones bears accommodation and domestic transportation costs.
- Time commitment: Volunteers teach 3-4 (40 min) lessons each day for a minimum of 3 weeks

6. Rural Volunteering Tours

- Overview: Volunteers teach English and conduct additional activities with the students at schools in rural China. This program is designed for corporate or school groups (grades 9 and above), and paid for by the company or school.

7. Special Educational Needs Program

- Overview: Volunteers teach English to autistic children or youth in Shanghai. Each class has 8 students, with several classroom helpers to assist in each classroom. Volunteers need to have at least four years of professional teaching experience
- Time commitment: 35-minute English lessons once a week to three classes. Minimum commitment of 8 weeks.

1. Stepping Up Digital Literacy

- Overview: Online and in-person computer/life skills classes for disadvantaged children and youth in China. Volunteers need to be native Chinese-speakers.
- Time commitment: Half a day per week for a minimum of one school term (3-4 months) or 4-6 weeks during the summer.

- Overview: Full-day camps for children in Shanghai with courses in a variety of subjects, including English, digital literacy, arts and crafts, reading, music, drama, science, dance and environment. Volunteers need to have fluent or native level of Chinese.
- Time commitment: One day per week for a minimum of 4 weeks during the summer (July and August).
